- 1 Commending Mr. James Lee Adams; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. James Lee Adams of Mitchell County, Georgia, was named the 2000
3 Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams is the first Georgian to receive this distinguished award; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he received degrees from Georgia Tech and Auburn University and, in 1969,
6 left his job developing computer programs at Lockheed Aircraft to return to the family
7 farming business; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he has built an efficient and cost-effective farming operation which includes
9 growing pecans, peanuts, cotton, and corn and raising stocker cattle and alligators and which
10 has poultry broiler houses; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams has become a leading spokesman for agriculture and an industry
12 leader and has appeared before Congress and in international trade negotiations; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he is the president of the American Soybean Association; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he and his wife, Sue, are the proud parents of three daughters: Vicki Adams
15 Davis; Susan Adams Glass, whose husband, Mark, works with the family farm operation;
16 and Sarah Adams, who is a student at Brenau College; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams has brought great honor and recognition to the State of Georgia as
18 a result of being named Southeastern Farmer of the Year; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
20 distinguished Georgian be recognized.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend Mr. James Lee Adams on his many outstanding accomplishments and especially
23 for being named the Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year.
