A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Timothy Hallam Reitz; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Timothy Hallam Reitz, a member of Troop 2000 in Duluth, Georgia, will
3 receive the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Court of Honor Ceremony in March 17, 2001;

- 5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest
6 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
8 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
9 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 11 of
11 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Timothy Hallam Reitz serves as a Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, is the recipient
13 of a Presidential Service Award, the Service to America Award, the 50 Miler Award,
14 numerous Historic Trail Awards, and is a member of the Order of the Arrow; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Timothy Hallam Reitz has brought honor to
16 himself and to his family, his church, and his troop.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Timothy Hallam Reitz
18 is recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he is extended the
19 best wishes of each member of this body for success and happiness in future endeavors.
