A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To define a certain term; to provide that there shall be no land-disturbing activities on a
- 2 coastal hammock in Chatham County; to provide criteria to be considered in considering a
- 3 waiver for hardship; to provide for the minimization of the impact on coastal hammocks; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 (a) As used in this Act the term:
- 8 (1) 'Coastal hammock' means any hammock adjacent to or surrounded by saltwater.
- 9 (2) 'Hammock' means an upland island that is surrounded by marsh or water at mean
- 10 high tide.
- 11 (b) There shall be no land-disturbing activities allowed on coastal hammocks in Chatham
- 12 County unless an unusual hardship exists. It shall be the duty of the applicant to demonstrate
- 13 to the governing authority of Chatham County that such an unusual hardship exists. If a
- land-disturbing activity is permitted by the governing authority, the area of coastal hammock
- 15 to be altered must be as small as practicable for the purpose stated. Appropriate and
- 16 practicable steps must be taken to minimize the adverse impact on the coastal hammock and
- 17 surrounding marshland."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
