Moore, attorney and former Georgia Bulldog quarterback; Georgia 17 State Senator Sonny Perdue; Georgia State Representative George DeLoach; Randy Jones, 18 publisher and owner of Worth Enterprises; and Boyd Austin, Mayor of Dallas, Georgia; and 19
