A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Herbert C. Green; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Herbert C. Green was born on July 6, 1921, in Norcross, Georgia, and he
3 entered the U.S. Army Air Corps in 1942 as a private and was honorably discharged in 1946
4 as a sergeant after having served in the Second World War; and

5 WHEREAS, he has been a union leader since his election as alternate committeeman in
6 1950, then he was elected as committeeman in 1952 and then as chairman of the bargaining
7 unit in 1954, where he served until he joined the international union staff in 1962 as a
8 representative in the national election department, and in 1986 he combined the international
9 representative position with the CAP/Education, and he was in charge of Region 8 Summer
10 School beginning in 1965 and retired from the international union staff in August, 1986; and

11 WHEREAS, he has been a member of the Gwinnett County Democratic Party for 52 years
12 and a member of the State Democratic Committee since 1960, and he was elected to five
13 Democratic National Conventions; and

14 WHEREAS, he is a member of the NAACP organization and served on the Governor's
15 advisory board and served as chairman and member of the Governor's Unemployment
16 Compensation Board from 1964 to the present; and

17 WHEREAS, he has been a member of United Winters Chapel Church in Norcross for 70
18 years, and his daughter, Kathy, is the fifth generation of his family to belong to the church;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, he and his wife, Autince, have two children, Kathy and Terry, and five
21 grandchildren.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend Mr. Herbert C. Green for his many contributions and
3 accomplishments.
