#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Sandra Caldwell Glass; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Sandra Caldwell Glass is well-known and highly respected in Oconee County  
3 where she served continuously as the Clerk of Superior Court from 1979 through 2000; and

4 WHEREAS, she began working for Oconee County in 1968 as an appointed deputy clerk of  
5 superior court and she was elected to fill the unexpired term of Clerk of Superior Court  
6 Bessie O'Dillon in June, 1979, and completed five full terms of service; and

7 WHEREAS, her grandfather, father, and mother served as clerks of superior court in Greene  
8 County for 55 years, and she has ably performed the complex tasks of her position with great  
9 care and attention to legal detail, recordkeeping, and organization; and

10 WHEREAS, she has served on the Superior Court Clerks Training Council, been chairperson  
11 of the 10th Judicial District Superior Court Clerks, an instructor in Clerks required training  
12 seminars, member of the Georgia Jury Standards Committee and the Superior Court Clerks  
13 Retirement Board, was president of the Superior Court Clerks Association of Georgia  
14 1993-94, and was named Superior Court Clerk of the Year for 1998-1999; and

15 WHEREAS, her extraordinary dedication to public service reflects the highest ideals  
16 expected of public officials and serves as a model for others to follow.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
18 recognize and commend Sandra Caldwell Glass for her exemplary public service as Clerk  
19 of Superior Court for Oconee County and convey to her their respect and best wishes for  
20 health and happiness in her retirement.
