- 2 WHEREAS, Woody Gap School was founded in 1940 on the original homesite of former
- 3 Georgia Governor Joseph E. Brown; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the school educates students in grades K-12 with a total enrollment of 93, being
- 5 the smallest public school in Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, over 60 percent of the school's faculty holds advanced degrees; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the school was selected as a "No Excuses" school for academic achievement
- 8 by the Georgia Public Policy Foundation and selected as a "Rural Challenge School" and
- 9 participates as a 21st Leadership School and was selected as a "School of Recognition" by
- 10 the Atlanta Committee for the Olympic Games; and
- 11 WHEREAS, all five graduating seniors: Daniel Gaines Etheridge, Nathaniel Cone Etheridge,
- 12 Timothy Charles Holgate, Candice Leigh Jordan, and Benjamin Webster Parks have been
- 13 accepted and will be attending postsecondary education, and a state and national acceptance
- 14 record of 100 percent have passed the Georgia High School graduation test and qualify for
- 15 the HOPE scholarship in addition to being active in clubs, sports, and community activities
- 16 and have an average Scholastic Aptitude Test score of 1100; and
- WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of thissuperlative school be recognized appropriately.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
  commend the Woody Gap School on its outstanding dedication and commitment to
