A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend an Act providing for the compensation of certain county officers and officials of DeKalb County, approved March 31, 1976 (Ga. L. 1976, p. 3986), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 4, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3822), so as to change the provisions relating to compensation of the chief executive officer and members of the board of commissioners; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act providing for the compensation of certain county officers and officials of DeKalb County, approved March 31, 1976 (Ga. L. 1976, p. 3986), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 4, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 3822), is amended by striking Section 2.1 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Section 2.1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2.1.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the chief executive officer of DeKalb County shall receive an annual salary equal to 100 percent of the gross salary as defined in Section 1 and the members of the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County shall receive an annual salary equal to 19 percent of the gross salary as defined in Section 1. Such salaries shall be payable in equal bimonthly installments from the funds of DeKalb County."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2002.
