3 Association state championship at the Macon Coliseum; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Patriots routed a formidable rival, Mitchell-Baker High School, 78-44 for
5 the Class AAA state title; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Greg Tinch and Darrell Williams scored 20 points apiece to lead Westover,

- 15 WHEREAS, the Patriots completed their season with a remarkable record of 29 wins and 3
16 losses; and
- 17 WHEREAS, all of their fans, families, the City of Albany, and the County of Dougherty are
18 justifiably proud of the inspiring achievement of the "Mighty" Red, White, and Blue
