## A RESOLUTION

3 where he actively contributed to the religious and civic affairs of his community; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born in Coffee County, and he earned a bachelor of science degree from  
5 the University of Georgia in 1948 and a master of science degree from the University of  
6 Illinois in 1954; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he served his country with diligence as a member of the U.S. Navy during  
8 World War II, and his military service was a source of honor throughout his life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he retired from the Agricultural Extension Service of the University of Georgia,  
10 was a valuable member of the Older Americans Council of Middle Georgia where he was  
11 a very strong advocate of the Meals on Wheels program, and was a dedicated member of the  
12 Jones County Kiwanis Club; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he and his wife, Virginia, were members of the Gray United Methodist Church  
14 and the proud parents of three daughters: Lynne Wilcox, Carol King, and Susan Lee Wilcox.

16 this body expresses its regret at the passing of Rodney Wilcox and conveys its sincerest
