## A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Horace S. (Bud) Kelley, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Horace S. (Bud) Kelley, Jr., will be remembered as an outstanding citizen of  
3 Griffin and Spalding County where he devoted much of his time since retiring to the  
4 community of his birth; and

5 WHEREAS, he was born on January 12, 1933, to Lucille and Horace Kelley, graduated from  
6 Griffin High school in 1951, and graduated from North Georgia College in 1955, received  
7 a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant and entered the Army in January, 1956, where he had a  
8 long and distinguished career and retired with the prestigious rank of Colonel in 1983; and

9 WHEREAS, he married Joy Beddingfield of Augusta, Georgia, in December of 1956, and  
10 they had two sons, Stanley Ware Kelley and John William Kelley, and six grandchildren; and

11 WHEREAS, he worked for the California Institute of Technology in Pasadena, Washington,  
12 and Atlanta, and he then worked for Mystech Associates, Inc. until he retired in 1997; and

13 WHEREAS, he became interested and involved in local government and public affairs and  
14 served with integrity as the Chairman of the Spalding Republican Party for the rest of his life.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body expresses regret  
16 at the passing of Horace S. (Bud) Kelley, Jr., and conveys its sympathy to the members of  
17 his beloved family.
