4 Champion AA High School Football Team in 1963; and

5 WHEREAS, he received a degree from Emory University in 1969 and graduated from the
6 University of Georgia Law School in 1972, after which he served three years in the United
7 States Air Force; and

8 WHEREAS, after leaving the Air Force, he married Martiti Camp, and the couple raised two
9 children, Edward, now age 20, and Joanna, now age 18; and

10 WHEREAS, he has been a active member of the State Bar of Georgia and is currently
11 president for 2000-2001; and he served as president-elect in 1999-2000; treasurer,
12 1997-1999; executive committee, 1994-present; Board of Governors, 1979-present; board
13 of trustees, Institute of Continuing Legal Education, 1997-1998; Advisory Committee on
14 Legislation, 1991-present; chairman, 1996-1997; Personnel Committee, 1996-present;
15 Program Committee, 1995-present; Finance Committee, 1997-present; Long Range Planning
16 Committee, 1997-present; Statewide Judicial Evaluation Committee, 1996-1997; and
17 Executive Committee Liaison to Bench and Bar Committee and Client's Security Fund board
18 of trustees, 1998-1999; and

19 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
20 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of his
21 community have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and
