- 2 WHEREAS, Honorable J. Frank Murrah, Sr., the son of the late George G. Murrah, Sr. and
3 Lurlie Murrah, was born on October 3, 1915, in Carroll County; and
- 4 WHEREAS, his lifelong work as a tiller of the soil and producer of food and fiber for the
5 citizens of Georgia has been recognized and honored by his fellow agricultural producers;

- 7 WHEREAS, his love and stewardship of the soil and water resources of Georgia have
8 inspired generations of Georgians to protect and preserve the state's precious natural
9 resources; and
- 10 WHEREAS, his 45 years of dedicated and distinguished service as supervisor of the Lower
11 Chattahoochee Soil and Water Conservation District is sincerely appreciated by his fellow
12 board members; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he provided state-wide leadership on soil and water conservation policy as a
14 member of the Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission from 1973 to 1989; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was known and respected for his lifelong service to the City of Richland and
16 Stewart County as an Eagle Scout, a member of the Richland Lions Club, a member of the
17 City Council of the City of Richland, a member of the Stewart Home Guard, chairman of the
18 Board of Directors of the Stewart-Webster Hospital Authority, a member of Smith Lodge
19 No. 85 F&AM, 32nd Degree Scottish Rite, and a trustee of the Richland United Methodist
20 Church; and
- 21 WHEREAS, he was the devoted husband of Mrs. Betty Ann Murrah.
