A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to animals, so as to
- 2 provide for the establishment of a dog and cat sterilization support program and educational
- 3 activities; to provide for funds; to provide for rules; to provide for reports; to amend Article
- 4 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration
- 5 and licensing of motor vehicles generally, so as to authorize the issuance of license plates
- 6 promoting the dog and cat sterilization support program and related educational activities of
- 7 the Department of Agriculture; to provide procedures for acquiring such license plates; to
- 8 provide for licensing agreements; to provide for the cost of such license plates; to provide
- 9 for the transfer of such license plates; to provide for subsequent editions; to provide for the
- 10 disposition of the funds derived from the sale of the special license plates; to provide for
- effective dates and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

13 SECTION 1.

- 14 Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to animals, is amended by adding
- at the end thereof a new Chapter 15 to read as follows:

16 "CHAPTER 15

- 17 4-15-1.
- 18 (a) The Commissioner shall establish a dog and cat sterilization support program and
- educational activities in support thereof. The department shall utilize funds placed in the
- special fund for support of the dog and cat sterilization support program, any funds
- 21 appropriated to the department for such purposes, and any voluntary contributions made
- 22 to the department and designated by the donor as being for the support of such program and
- 23 activities solely for the implementation, operation, and support of such programs and for
- sterilization programs authorized under this chapter. The Commissioner is authorized to

1 promulgate rules to direct and administer the dog and cat sterilization support program and

- 2 to carry out this Code section.
- 3 (b) The Commissioner shall submit a report to the Senate Agriculture Committee and the
- 4 House Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Affairs detailing the receipt and
- 5 expenditure of all appropriated funds and all funds received from the sale of dog and cat
- 6 sterilization support license plates as provided by Code Section 40-2-49.2. Such report
- shall be made not later than the last day of August each year."

8 SECTION 2.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, is amended by adding, following Code
- 11 Section 40-2-49.1, a new Code Section 40-2-49.2 to read as follows:
- 12 "40-2-49.2.
- 13 (a) In order to promote and financially provide for dog and cat sterilization support
- programs and educational activities directly in support thereof, there shall be issued
- beginning January 1, 2003, special license plates promoting the dog and cat sterilization
- support program provided for in Code Section 4-15-1.
- 17 (b) The Department of Agriculture, in cooperation with the state revenue commissioner,
- shall design special distinctive license plates appropriate to promote dog and cat
- sterilization support programs. The dog and cat sterilization support license plate must be
- of the same size as general issue motor vehicle license plates and shall include a unique
- design and identifying number, whereby the total number of characters does not exceed six.
- No two recipients shall receive identically numbered plates. Such design shall provide
- space in which to indicate the name of the county of issuance.
- 24 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (b) of this Code section, this Code section
- shall not be implemented until such time as the State of Georgia has, through a licensing
- agreement or otherwise, received such licenses or other permissions as may be required to
- 27 implement this Code section. The design of the initial edition of the dog and cat
- 28 sterilization support license plate, as well as the design of subsequent editions and
- 29 excepting only any part or parts of the designs owned by others and licensed to the state,
- shall be owned solely by the State of Georgia for its exclusive use and control, except as
- authorized by the Commissioner of Agriculture. The Commissioner of Agriculture may
- take such steps as may be necessary to give notice of and protect such right, including the
- copyright or copyrights. However, such steps shall be cumulative of the ownership and
- exclusive use and control established by this subsection as a matter of law, and no person
- 35 shall reproduce or otherwise use such design or designs, except as authorized by the
- 36 Commissioner of Agriculture.

1 (d) Beginning in calendar year 2003, any Georgia resident who is the owner of a motor

- 2 vehicle, except a vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan, upon
- 3 complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor
- 4 vehicles and upon the payment of a fee of \$25.00 in addition to the regular motor vehicle
- 5 registration fee, shall be issued a dog and cat sterilization support license plate.
- 6 Revalidation decals shall be issued for dog and cat sterilization support license plates in the
- 7 same manner as provided for general issue license plates.
- 8 (e) The funds derived from the sale of dog and cat sterilization support license plates, less
- 9 a \$1.00 processing fee which shall be granted to county tag offices per plate sold and less
- the actual manufacturing cost of the plates shall be deposited in the special fund for support
- of the dog and cat sterilization support program created by Article III, Section IX,
- Paragraph VI(1) of the Constitution of the State of Georgia. As soon as practicable after
- December 31 of each year, the state revenue commissioner shall report the net amount
- derived from the sale of dog and cat sterilization support license plates to the Department
- of Agriculture.
- 16 (f) An applicant may request a dog and cat sterilization support license plate any time
- during the applicant's registration period. If such a license plate is to replace a current
- valid license plate, the Department of Revenue shall issue the dog and cat sterilization
- support license plate with appropriate decals attached. When an applicant requests a dog
- and cat sterilization support license plate at the beginning of the registration period, the
- applicant shall pay the tax together with all applicable fees.
- 22 (g) Dog and cat sterilization support license plates shall be transferred from one vehicle
- to another vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Code Section 40-2-42.
- 24 (h) Dog and cat sterilization support license plates shall be issued within 30 days of
- 25 application."

26 SECTION 3.

- 27 (a) This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002, for the purpose of designing and
- 28 manufacturing dog and cat sterilization support license plates and for the adoption of rules
- 29 and regulations necessary to carry out this Act and shall become effective for all purposes
- 30 on January 1, 2003.
- 31 (b) If an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia authorizing the creation of
- 32 a special fund for support of the dog and cat sterilization support program is not ratified at
- 33 the general election in 2002, this Act shall be repealed in its entirety on January 1, 2003, and
- 34 no such motor vehicle license plates shall be issued pursuant to this Act.
- 35 SECTION 4.
- 36 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
