A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Calvin Hughes; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Calvin Hughes is a graduate of the University of Missouri in Columbia with a
3 degree in journalism; and

4 WHEREAS, he has worked as a journalist in Missouri, Indiana, and Texas and is currently
5 in Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he is a devoted husband to his wife Kimberly and a loving father to their two
7 children, Kimberly and Kristen; and

8 WHEREAS, as a journalist, he has reported numerous stories about dangerous driving and
9 the sad human consequences of drunk, drugged, distracted, or aggressive driving; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Hughes lives his concept of broadcast journalists as public servants who
11 have a responsibility to advocate on behalf of the state's citizens for safe streets and
12 highways; and

13 WHEREAS, on March 7, 2001, Mr. Hughes was the recipient of the 2001 Excellence in
14 Journalism award at the seventh annual Safe Drivers' Awareness Day for Sharing the Road;
15 Beware Dangerous, Drunk, Drugged, and Aggressive Drivers.
