ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the founding of Iron City, Georgia; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Town of Iron City was incorporated in Decatur County, Georgia, on
4 December 20, 1900, by Act of the General Assembly of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Decatur County was divided in 1923 and newly created Seminole County, the
6 most southwestern county in the state, now contains Iron City; and

7 WHEREAS, the town was established and continues with city limits extending one-half mile
8 in every direction from the depot in the middle of the town; and

9 WHEREAS, the circular city limits provide a home for 153 homes, 13 businesses, six
10 churches, and, according to the 1990 census, 508 citizens; and

11 WHEREAS, this gracious small town provides a harmonious and wonderful home and an
12 outstanding quality of life for its residents and a focal gathering point for the surrounding
13 community in Seminole County; and

14 WHEREAS, there will be a 100th Anniversary celebration held in Iron City on April 14,
15 2001, to commemorate the founding and first century of existence of the town.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 hereby join in celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the founding of Iron City, Georgia, and
18 extend to each and every resident of the town their best wishes on this auspicious occasion.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the City of Iron City and its citizens,
