7 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties throughout his life
8 especially in his service to the City of Lilburn as a member of the city council from 1986 to
9 1991 and mayor from 1992 to 1995; and

11 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 12 WHEREAS, his unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience

- 16 WHEREAS, the untimely passing of this generous, kind, and devoted family man leaves an
17 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.
