## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Isaac Brown for his accomplishments as a member of the Buford High School  
2 Wolves basketball team; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Buford High School boys' basketball team in 2001 reached the Class A  
4 State Championship basketball game for the first time since 1996; and

5 WHEREAS, the team entered the postseason tournament with a winning percentage under  
6 .500 but beat the Number 8 and Number 1 seeds en route to the championship game; and

7 WHEREAS, the Buford High Wolves' season ended with a tough loss to Taylor County in  
8 the final game, but the team's great efforts under Coach Gerald Arnold led to an overall  
9 17-16 record and a trip to the championship; and

10 WHEREAS, Isaac Brown played an important role for the Wolves, received the team's Most  
11 Valuable Player Award, was named as a Class A All State Team honorable mention player,  
12 and was named to the All County Teams of the *Gwinnett Extra*, the *Gwinnett Daily Post*, and  
13 the Tipoff Club.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 this body recognizes and commends Isaac Brown for his hard work, accomplishments, and  
16 sportsmanship in the outstanding 2000-2001 season of the Buford High School Wolves
