## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 2001 Jewish Community Center Maccabi Games; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, from August 5 through August 9, 2001, Atlanta will host the 2001 Jewish  
3 Community Center Maccabi Games; and
- 4 WHEREAS, 2,000 Jewish teenagers from more than 30 metropolitan areas in the United  
5 States, Canada, Great Britain, and Israel will compete in Atlanta in over 18 Olympic-style  
6 sports; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this event is more than a sporting event in that it will bring together local  
8 residents to serve as volunteers and host families and will emphasize competing with dignity,  
9 sportsmanship, and spirit; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the most unique aspect of this event will be "A Day of Caring and Sharing" on  
11 August 7, 2001, when the teen athletes will take time away from athletic competition to  
12 dedicate themselves to bettering the Atlanta metropolitan community by performing over  
13 2,400 hours of community service.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 the members of this body recognize the 2001 Jewish Community Center Maccabi Games  
16 taking place in Atlanta from August 5 through August 9, 2001, and commend all the athletes,  
17 parents, coaches, volunteers, and host families for their dedication to making this event a  
18 success.
