3 where he established the Air Force Junior ROTC program at Shiloh High School in Snellville
4 in August 1987; and

7 of Gwinnett County teenagers; and

12 Championship during 8 of the last 12 years: 1989, 1991 to 1994, 1996, 1998, and 2000; and

14 Outstanding AFJROTC Instructor in 1990, 1991, and 2000.
