A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 27-4-194 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the

- 2 minimum size of shellfish which may be taken for commercial or noncommercial purposes,
- 3 so as to provide that it shall be unlawful to take or possess clams when the maximum depth
- 4 of the shell of the clam measures less than three-fourths' inch thickness; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 27-4-194 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the minimum
- 10 size of shellfish which may be taken for commercial or noncommercial purposes, is amended
- by striking in its entirety subsection (b) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 12 "(b) It shall be unlawful to take or possess any clam for commercial or recreational
- purposes when the maximum depth of the shell of the clam measures less than one three-
- 14 <u>fourths'</u> inch thickness from one shell half to the other unless prior written approval has
- been obtained from the department and such approval is on the person of the harvester or
- person in possession of the clam."

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
