A RESOLUTION

To designate the James Hulman Stanford Memorial Bridge in Putnam County; and for other

purposes.

WHEREAS, Mr. James Hulman Stanford was born in Putnam County, Georgia, on June 15,

1910, to a family which has been in Putnam County for over 200 years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Stanford served his country with honor and distinction in the United States

Navy during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Stanford worked in the logging industry and also had an exemplary career

of public service with the Federal Soil and Water Conservation Service; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Stanford was a leader and active participant in civic affairs in his

community and the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY that the bridge

by which Hillsboro Road in Putnam County crosses over Murder Creek is hereby designated

as the James Hulman Stanford Memorial Bridge, and the Department of Transportation or

the governing authority of Putnam County or both, as may be appropriate, are authorized to

erect and maintain signs so designating said bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed

to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of James Hulman Stanford.
