A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 30 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 optometrists, so as to change the provisions relating to scope of practice; to repeal conflicting
- 3 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Chapter 30 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to optometrists,
- 7 is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (2) of Code Section 43-30-1, relating to
- 8 definitions, a new subparagraph to read as follows:
- 9 "(I) Optometrists who are certified to use pharmaceutical agents for treatment purposes
- shall have the authority to prescribe and administer oral pharmaceutical agents, in
- addition to the analgesics which alone are subject to the restrictions of subparagraph
- (D) of this paragraph, for the treatment of conditions of the eye and eyelid only. The
- treatment of nonocular medical conditions is specifically prohibited. Optometrists may
- not prescribe those pharmaceutical agents listed in Schedules I and II of Article 2 of
- 15 Chapter 13 of Title 16, the 'Georgia Controlled Substances Act.'"

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
