## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 alteration of speed limits by local authorities, so as to change the provisions relating to
- 3 authorized alteration of speed limits with respect to school speed zones; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alteration of
- 8 speed limits by local authorities, is amended by striking subsection (d) in its entirety and
- 9 inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 10 "(d) Not more than six alterations as authorized in this Code section shall be made per mile
- along a street or highway, except in the case of reduced limits at intersections. The
- difference between adjacent limits shall not be more than ten miles per hour, except for
- reductions for school speed zones, which may be not more than 20 miles per hour when a
- warning sign is placed 700 feet in advance of the point at which the speed reduction is
- 15 required."

16 SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
