A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 alteration of speed limits by local authorities, so as to change the provisions relating to  
3 authorized alteration of speed limits with respect to school speed zones; to repeal conflicting  
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alteration of  
8 speed limits by local authorities, is amended by striking subsection (d) in its entirety and  
9 inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) to read as follows:

10 "(d) Not more than six alterations as authorized in this Code section shall be made per mile  
11 along a street or highway, except in the case of reduced limits at intersections. The  
12 difference between adjacent limits shall not be more than ten miles per hour, except for  
13 reductions for school speed zones, which may be not more than 20 miles per hour ~~when a~~  
14 ~~warning sign is placed 700 feet in advance of the point at which the speed reduction is~~  
15 ~~required."~~

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
