A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Lieutenant Bill L. Mull; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Bill L. Mull of the Cobb County Police Department received the
3 Officer of the Year for Meritorious Service Award for 2000 from the Peace Officers
4 Association of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he began his career with the Cobb County Police Department on April 16, 1966,
6 and was assigned to the Uniform Patrol Bureau; in 1972, he was appointed to the newly
7 created Metropolitan Atlanta Narcotics Squad; in 1976, he was assigned to the Property
8 Crimes division; in 1979, he returned to the Uniform Patrol Bureau; he commanded the
9 D.U.I. Task Force from 1986 through 1993 when he became the adjutant to the Deputy Chief
10 of Police; and, in 1999, he was appointed to command the police rangers; and
- 11 WHEREAS, throughout his 34 years of service, he has demonstrated an excellent knowledge
12 of law enforcement procedure and an abiding commitment to public safety standards of
13 conduct, and his superiors have regularly recognized his ability and teamwork; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he has performed his official duties with the utmost dedication and care, and
15 his service has consistently been worthy of confidence and public trust; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he has contributed substantially to the peace and safety of the community he
17 serves, and his professionalism and diligence merit the highest praise.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Lieutenant Bill L. Mull on receiving the Officer of the Year for
20 Meritorious Service Award for 2000.
