A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Marietta High School 2001 Girls Track Team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Marietta High School 2001 Girls Track Team brought honor and fame to
3 the school and community by winning the highly coveted title "State Champions" for the first
4 time in the history of the girls track team; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the members of this championship team demonstrated their exceptional ability,
6 motivation, and commitment throughout the season and won second place in Region 5; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the 4x100 meter relay team of Dominique Davis, Lynnsey Sherrod-Dailey,
8 Tisilli Rogers, and Fran Barnett won the state championship in 47.0 seconds, and the 4x400
9 meter relay team of Tisilli Rogers, Lauren Jacobs, Lynnsey Sherrod-Dailey, and Fran Barnett
10 won the state championship in 3 minutes 50.02 seconds; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Tisilli Rogers won the state championship in the 100 meter dash (11.68 sec.);
12 Lynnsey Sherrod-Dailey won the state championship in 300 meter hurdles (42.09 sec.) and
13 placed second in the 110 meter hurdles; and Fran Barnett placed second in the 400 meter
14 hurdles; and
- 15 WHEREAS, James "Friday" Richards has proudly served as the Girls Coach for many years
16 at Marietta High School, and his experience, encouragement, and dedication have contributed
17 greatly to the tremendous success of this first state championship team.

19 commend the Marietta High School 2001 Girls Track Team on winning the state title and
20 convey their heartiest congratulations to the team and Coach Richards.
