2 Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Shaw High School Baseball Team brought fame and honor to the school,  
4 team, coaches, and community by winning the 2001 Class AAAA State Championship on  
5 May 31, 2001; and

6 WHEREAS, the Shaw High School Raiders captured the state title with a 11-10 and 2-1  
7 sweep of Columbus before a fully-packed stadium throughout the thrilling doubleheader; and

8 WHEREAS, these exceptional young athletes demonstrated their superior talent, drive,
