A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Virlyn Branham Moore, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Virlyn Branham Moore, Jr., was a distinguished gentleman, a lawyer, teacher,
3 banker, athlete, and civic leader who influenced the lives of countless Georgians throughout
4 his impressive career and his memory is honored by all who knew him; and

5 WHEREAS, he was born on February 22, 1911, the son of the late Virlyn B. Moore, Chief
6 Judge of Fulton County Superior Court, graduated from Emory University in 1931, from the
7 University of Georgia School of Law in 1934, from the FBI Academy in 1941, and the
8 Military Government School in 1944; and

9 WHEREAS, he served as Special Agent for the FBI from 1941-1944, was in the United
10 States Navy from 1944-1946, and practiced law in Atlanta until 1949 when he joined the
11 Fulton National Bank as Senior Vice President over its Trust Division until 1976 when he
12 assumed the duties as President of the Woodrow Wilson College of Law where he had taught
13 since 1954; and

14 WHEREAS, he was a former member of the board of trustees of Reinhart College, Oxford
15 College at Emory University, and the Boys Clubs of Atlanta, and he was the past president
16 of the Georgia Bar Association, the Atlanta Historical Association, and the Kiwanis Club of
17 Atlanta and was the author of articles on the Civil War and was a featured public speaker;

19 WHEREAS, this distinguished Georgian was widely known and respected in educational,
20 financial, legal, and religious circles and his life was one of tremendous accomplishment.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body express regret at the passing of Virlyn Branham Moore, Jr., and
23 convey their sympathy to the members of his beloved family.
