A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending and congratulating the Cherokee Reds Baseball Team; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Cherokee Reds traveled 850 miles to Arlington, Texas, to capture the 2001
3 Super Series National Championship; and
- 4 WHEREAS, playing in temperatures over 100 degrees, the Reds met the challenges of each
5 game with remarkable confidence and drive and managed to go undefeated in winning the
6 national championship; and
- 7 WHEREAS, out of 50 teams entered in the tournament from several states, the final two
8 teams hailed from Georgia: "Cobb County's Finest," the East Cobb Blazers, and "Cherokee
9 County's Team," the Cherokee Reds; and
- 10 WHEREAS, although the Reds had posted a regular season record of 0-4-1 against the East
11 Cobb Blazers, they went into the championship game undaunted and managed to score ten
12 unanswered runs to beat the Blazers 10-7 to win the national championship; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the exceptional young athletes who make up the Reds demonstrated their
14 outstanding talent, drive, discipline, and teamwork throughout a long season and proved their
15 mettle to the delight of all Cherokee County; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the nine- year-old Reds are the very first traveling baseball team from Cherokee
17 County to win a national championship.

19 the members of this body heartily congratulate the Cherokee Reds, the 2001 Super Series
20 National Champions, and commend the outstanding achievement of players Brandon Able,
