A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Clayton R. Heyward on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

6 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities

- 10 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 11 of which are

15 and an educational exhibit for the Autrey Mill Nature Preserve; and
