A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Robertson E. Marsh on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Robertson E. Marsh of Boy Scout Troup 17 in Barnesville has earned the rank
3 of Eagle Scout; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout has been the symbol of the highest achievement
5 among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Robertson E. Marsh has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that
10 he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 11 of which are
12 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Robertson E. Marsh has met these demanding requirements through diligent
14 effort; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Robertson E. Marsh has brought honor not only
16 to himself but also to his family and troop.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 recognize and commend Robertson E. Marsh for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the
19 highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
