A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Jimmie Hodge Timmons; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Jimmie Hodge Timmons is well known to the members of this legislative body
3 where he served with honor and distinction from January, 1975, until January, 1992; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he graduated from Damascus High School in 1965, attended Abraham Baldwin
5 Agricultural College, earned a B.S. in agriculture from the University of Georgia in 1960,
6 and received a master's degree in school administration from Auburn University in 1965 and
7 an advanced degree in school administration from the University of Georgia in 1976; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was a vocational-agriculture teacher at Bainbridge High School, 1960-1964;
9 was the principal of Damascus Elementary School, 1964-1966; served in the Calhoun County
10 school system central office, 1966-1998; and was the school superintendent for the Calhoun
11 County school system from 1998 until July, 2001; and
- 12 WHEREAS, throughout his years of service in the Georgia State Senate, he provided
13 valuable information and direction on complex educational issues, contributed his opinions
14 and represented his constituency during committee deliberations, and was genuinely
15 concerned with the welfare of all Georgians; and
- 16 WHEREAS, his lifetime of public service to his community and state deserves proper
17 recognition and praise as he is one of Georgia's most dedicated public servants.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Jimmie Hodge Timmons for outstanding public service to the
20 people of Georgia and his local community and express to him their deep appreciation.
