## A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Lynann Stevenson Roberts; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Lynann Stevenson Roberts will be long remembered by her dearly beloved  
3 family and by her many students, parents, and fellow teachers whose lives were touched by  
4 this wonderful classroom teacher; and

5 WHEREAS, she was born on March 10, 1953, in Altoona, Pennsylvania; received a B.S.  
6 degree from the College of Human Development at Pennsylvania State University; and was  
7 certified to teach elementary education and home economics; and

8 WHEREAS, she began teaching in 1976 in Altoona, Pennsylvania, and later taught in the  
9 elementary and preschool programs in Burlington, Gibbsboro, Cherry Hill, and Barrington,  
10 New Jersey, before coming to Georgia where she taught in the City of Marietta school  
11 system in 1996-1998 and taught the fourth grade at the St. Francis Day School in Roswell,  
12 Georgia, beginning in August, 1998; and

13 WHEREAS, she was an excellent classroom teacher who was committed to exploring  
14 techniques to enable all students to learn, and she actively involved parents in the learning  
15 process and communicated regularly with them; and

16 WHEREAS, she was a loving partner to her husband, Craig A. Roberts, and an  
17 understanding and supportive mother to two very fortunate sons, Christopher and Kyle, and  
18 her family will treasure their memories forever.
