A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives with respect to the events of September
2 11, 2001; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, a group or groups still unidentified committed
4 unprecedented and heretofore unimagined acts of war against the United States of America
5 and its citizens; and

6 WHEREAS, our union, its member states, and its people stand as one against this attack.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
8 this body hereby pledges on behalf of the State of Georgia its strongest support for the
9 national government of the United States in identifying, locating, and appropriately
10 retaliating against the group or groups responsible for the infamous and despicable actions
11 of September 11.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body hereby extends to those injured and killed on
13 September 11 and their families its deepest sympathies and condolences.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body hereby recognizes and commends the many
15 members of the Armed Services, public safety and rescue officers, and citizen volunteers
16 who have worked and are working so tirelessly and selflessly in our country's rescue and
17 recovery efforts.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as our nation moves on to recover from and respond to
19 these terrible events, we humbly ask that God may bless America.
