A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Sheriff Phil Summers and the members of the Catoosa County Sheriff's Office;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Sheriff Phil Summers is an outstanding law enforcement officer who has
4 contributed substantially to the peace and safety of the community he serves and to the
5 welfare of its citizens; and

6 WHEREAS, Sheriff Summers has a special regard for his fellow citizens and their families
7 and has instilled in his staff the personal dedication, discipline, and thoroughness he has
8 toward the duties of his office; and

9 WHEREAS, he and the members of the Catoosa County Sheriff's Office have consistently
10 conducted their responsibilities with the utmost ability, care, and integrity and in so doing
11 have earned the confidence and trust of the community they serve; and

12 WHEREAS, Sheriff Summers and the members of the Catoosa County Sheriff's Office have
13 worked to end the video poker industry and, with and through their assistance, the General
14 Assembly has now enacted a ban on video poker in Georgia.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize and commend Sheriff Phil Summers and the members of the Catoosa County
17 Sheriff's Office on their excellent record of accomplishments; their commitment to ensuring
18 the peace, safety, and welfare of the public; and for their assistance and support in ending
19 video poker in Georgia.
