A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing the support of the Georgia House of Representatives for the President of the
2 United States of America and the members of our nation's armed forces in the current
3 national emergency; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, on the evening of September 20, 2001, President George W. Bush addressed
5 the Congress of the United States in joint session, wherein he laid out his response to those
6 recent acts of war committed against the people and government of these United States by
7 terrorist groups which caused the loss of thousands of American lives; and

8 WHEREAS, the President's address made clear to the Congress, the nation, and the world
9 that the people of this nation are united and altogether determined upon a firm and honorable
10 course of action designed to preserve, protect, and defend the lives and liberties that we as
11 Americans hold so dear; and

12 WHEREAS, the Georgia House of Representatives is united in its support of our President
13 as commander in chief and of the sons and daughters of this nation, including many
14 Georgians, who as members of the armed forces are responding to the call of duty in this
15 time of peril.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body do express their support for the President and the armed forces of
18 the United States in this current national emergency, with the resolute conviction that
19 "conquer we must, for our cause it is just, And this be our motto: 'In God is our trust!' And
20 the star-spangled banner in triumph shall wave, O'er the land of the free and the home of the
21 brave."

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
23 and directed to forthwith transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the President of
24 the United States of America.
