A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing deep regret at the passing of Corporal Aubrey Lee Mitchell, Sr.; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on August 24, 2001, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
4 distinguished citizens with the untimely passing of Corporal Aubrey Lee Mitchell, Sr.; and

16 loyalty, fine leadership, and a sensitivity to the needs of others; and

17 WHEREAS, he was devoted to his wife, Linda, and his children, Aubrey Lee, Jr. and Janet,
18 and Barry and Greg, who preceded him in death; and the untimely passing of this generous
19 and kind man leaves an unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.
