## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, known as the "Budget Act," so as to eliminate provisions relating to the annual
- 3 continuation budget report; to provide for the periodic application of zero-base budgeting to
- 4 the budget process; to provide for analysis of departmental and program objectives; to
- 5 provide for consideration of alternative funding levels; to provide for departmental priority
- 6 lists; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 known as the "Budget Act," is amended by striking Code Section 45-12-75.1, relating to the
- annual continuation budget report, and inserting in its place a new Code section to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 "45-12-75.1.
- 14 (a) On or before October 1 of 1994 and each year thereafter, the Governor, through the
- Office of Planning and Budget, shall prepare and submit to the Budgetary Responsibility
- Oversight Committee a continuation budget report. On or before May 1 of 1994 and every
- year thereafter, the Governor, through the Office of Planning and Budget, shall consult and
   coordinate with the chairperson of the Budgetary Responsibility Oversight Committee to
- develop a list of agencies and programs in agencies which will be included in the
- 20 continuation budget report for the year. Each state department shall be included in the
- 21 continuation budget report not less than once every five years. The continuation budget
- 22 report shall contain a detailed analysis of the funds necessary to provide services in the
- 23 current fiscal year for each state agency and program examined. Such report shall address
- 24 all programs and shall include a description of the purposes and accomplishments of the
- 25 programs.

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1 (b) The committee shall consider the budget report prepared pursuant to this Code section

- 2 in conjunction with the audit report prepared pursuant to paragraph (4) of Code Section
- 3 <del>50-6-24.</del>
- 4 (c) The committee shall submit to the membership of the General Assembly within one
- 5 week of the convening of each regular session of the General Assembly a list of all
- 6 programs included in the continuation budget report for each department examined as well
- 7 as actions recommended, if any, by the committee.
- 8 (d) It is the intent of this Code section to examine all state departments not less than once
- 9 every five years.
- 10 (a) The Governor in preparing his or her budget report under Code Section 45-12-75, and
- budget units in preparing their budget estimates under Code Section 45-12-78, shall make
- 12 <u>use of zero-base budgeting as provided in this Code section. The requirements of this Code</u>
- 13 section shall apply with respect to the budget report presented to the General Assembly in
- 14 January of 2004 and each fourth year thereafter, it being the intent of this Code section that
- each Governor shall during the second year of his or her term present a budget report which
- incorporates zero-base budgeting.
- 17 (b) In the years in which zero-base budgeting applies, each budget unit shall include in its
- budget estimate an analysis summarizing past and proposed spending plans by program and
- 19 the means of financing the proposed plans. Information presented shall include the
- 20 <u>following:</u>
- 21 (1) A statement of the budget unit's departmental and program objectives, effectiveness
- 22 <u>measures, and program size indicators;</u>
- 23 (2) At least three alternative funding levels for each program with effectiveness measures
- 24 and program size indicators detailed for each alternative funding level; and
- 25 (3) A priority listing encompassing all alternative funding levels for all programs.
- 26 (c) In the years in which zero-base budgeting applies, the Governor shall include in the
- 27 <u>budget report relevant materials related to each budget unit's submission under</u>
- 28 <u>subsection (b) of this Code section and such other relevant material as deemed appropriate</u>
- by the Governor."

30 SECTION 2.

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
