

House Bill 57

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 28-11-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
2 board of the Georgia General Assembly Training Institute, so as to change the manner and  
3 method of appointing the members of the board; to provide an effective date; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 28-11-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the board of the  
8 Georgia General Assembly Training Institute, is amended by striking subsection (b) and  
9 inserting in its place a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

10 "(b) The board shall consist of seven members and shall be composed of ~~six~~ seven  
11 ~~members appointed by the Legislative Services Committee and as follows:~~

12 (1) ~~The~~ the director of the Vinson Institute who shall serve as an ex officio, nonvoting  
13 member. ~~In appointing members of the board, the Legislative Services Committee shall~~  
14 ~~select three members from each house and shall attempt to broadly reflect the~~  
15 ~~composition of the General Assembly;~~

16 (2) Three members of the Senate to be selected by the President Pro Tempore of the  
17 Senate or the designee of the President Pro Tempore, one of whom shall be designated  
18 as a cochairperson; and

19 (3) Three members of the House of Representative who shall be selected by the Speaker  
20 of the House, one of whom shall be designated as a cochairperson."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
23 without such approval.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
