## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elementary and secondary education, so as to provide for an exception to the prohibition
- 3 against sales to a county school board by a member; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and
- 8 secondary education, is amended by striking Code Section 20-2-505, relating to the
- 9 prohibition of a school board member from selling school supplies or equipment to county
- 10 board and a penalty, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 11 "20-2-505.
- 12 (a) No member of any county board of education in this state shall sell to any county board
- any supplies or equipment used, consumed, or necessary in the operation of any public
- school in this state.
- 15 (b) Any member of any county board violating subsection (a) of this Code section shall
- be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 17 (c) This Code section shall not apply to purchases of supplies or equipment that do not
- 18 exceed \$5,000.00 if there are fewer than three sources for such supplies or equipment
- 19 within the county."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
