## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Robert Huefner on his being named as one of only two recipients of the  
2 national 2002 Wendy's High School Heisman Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Robert Huefner's impressive scholastic achievements include a perfect 4.0  
4 grade point average; a ranking of second in his high school graduating class; a score of 1550  
5 on the SAT; a National Merit Finalist; a three-time member and captain of the National  
6 Champion Science Olympiad Team; and

7 WHEREAS, Robert Huefner's admirable athletic accomplishments include being named  
8 two-time captain of his soccer team; earning a letter in cross country; and earning a letter in  
9 football for kicking; and

10 WHEREAS, Robert Huefner's altruistic community participation includes helping build two  
11 houses in Juarez, Mexico, through the First Presbyterian Church as a part of youth group  
12 mission trips and volunteering at a local hospital, nursing homes, and a soup kitchen; and

13 WHEREAS, Robert Huefner's other prominent achievements, activities, and honors include  
14 serving as class president; serving as copy editor of his school newspaper; attaining the high  
15 honor of Eagle Scout; serving as a member of the student council; serving as a voting  
16 member and officer of the Peachtree City Youth Advisory Board; being selected by the  
17 American Legion as the Senior Senator Delegate from Georgia as one of 96 students invited  
18 to Washington, D.C., where he met the President of the United States; and drafting a  
19 resolution while in Washington, D.C., protecting the American flag, which passed the Boys  
20 Nation Senate; and

21 WHEREAS, Robert Huefner's highly commendable goals and ambitions include options for  
22 college education at Harvard, Duke, or Cornell, an ROTC college scholarship, and  
23 aspirations to become a military physician; and

1 WHEREAS, since 1994, the national Wendy's High School Heisman Award has been  
2 awarded to one male and one female high school student, based on leadership in academics,  
3 athletics, and community service; and

4 WHEREAS, over 13,500 students were nominated nation wide for the 2002 Wendy's High  
5 School Heisman Award; and

6 WHEREAS, as a result of his many outstanding honors and achievements, Robert Huefner  
7 was named on December 14, 2002, as one of only two National Award winners for the 2002  
8 Wendy's High School Heisman Award; and

9 WHEREAS, as the Wendy's High School Heisman National Award Winner, Robert Huefner  
10 was recognized during a live telecast of the Heisman Memorial Trophy Awards Show on  
11 ESPN and received a crystal trophy and \$2,500.00 for his high school.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
13 the members of this body commend Robert Huefner for his outstanding achievements.
