## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 9 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to fraud and related offenses, so as to change certain provisions related to failing to
- 3 pay for natural products or chattels; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article 4 of Chapter 9 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fraud
- 7 and related offenses, is amended by striking Code Section 16-9-58, relating to failing to pay
- 8 for natural products or chattels, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 9 "16-9-58.
- Any person, either on his or her own account or for others, who shall buy cotton, corn, rice,
- crude turpentine, spirits of turpentine, rosin, pitch, tar, timber, pulpwood, <u>Christmas trees</u>,
- 12 <u>horticultural crops, poultry and poultry products, cattle, hogs, sheep, goats, ratites, horses,</u>
- mules, pecans, peaches, apples, watermelons, cantaloupes, or other products or chattels and
- shall fail or refuse to pay therefor or shall make way with or dispose of the same before he
- or she shall have paid therefor unless credit shall be expressly extended therefor shall be
- guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned for not less than one
- year nor more than five years."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
