A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-1183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 prohibition of electronic pagers and communication devices, so as to authorize each local
- 3 board of education to establish a policy to either permit or prohibit the possession of
- 4 electronic communication devices by students in school; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 20-2-1183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prohibition
- 9 of electronic pagers and communication devices, is amended by striking said Code section
- 10 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 11 "20-2-1183.
- 12 (a) No local board of education shall permit any pupil to carry a pocket pager or electronic
- communication device in school except for health or other unusual reasons approved by
- 14 the board of education.
- 15 (b) Any student found in violation of the provisions of this Code section be subject to
- 16 placement in an alternative education program. The possession of an electronic
- 17 <u>communication device by a student in school shall be permitted or prohibited as</u>
- 18 <u>specifically prescribed by rule or policy set by the local board of education. If prohibited,</u>
- 19 the local board of education may provide for exceptions to such prohibition and for
- 20 <u>disciplinary actions for possession in violation of the prohibition.</u>"

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
