A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Honorable Susan W. Cable; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Honorable Susan W. Cable served with unparalleled ability as a member of the
3 Senate from 1999 through 2002; and

4 WHEREAS, this dynamic and powerful public servant faithfully represented the citizens of
5 Bibb, Crawford, Lamar, Monroe, and Upson counties with great distinction, dedication, and
6 ability; and

7 WHEREAS, her consistently thorough consideration of the issues presented to this
8 deliberative body and her integrity and reliability have rightfully earned her the honor,
9 respect, and trust of her colleagues over the years and were recognized by the leadership of
10 this body and properly reflected in her committee responsibilities which included serving as

2 inspiration, and direction for all and demonstrates the energy, devotion, and commitment that
3 is truly reflective of her outstanding character and ability; and

4 WHEREAS, her foresight and forthright determination have brought unparalleled progress
5 and a sense of destiny to the citizens of her district and the State of Georgia and it is
6 abundantly fitting and proper that the members of this body, most especially those to whom
7 she so freely imparted advice, encouragement, and friendship and who regard her with much
8 admiration and respect, pay appropriate tribute to one of their finest and most distinguished
9 colleagues for her impartial, well-reasoned, and enlightened service that she has rendered on
