

House Bill 218

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to general provisions of the State Road and Tollway Authority, so as to  
3 provide that any toll for SR 400 that is extended beyond the time necessary to pay off any  
4 debt associated with the construction of such route will be used only for maintenance of or  
5 improvements to such route or public roads connected with SR 400; to provide for related  
6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
10 relating to general provisions of the State Road and Tollway Authority, is amended by  
11 striking in its entirety Code Section 32-10-65.1 and inserting in its place the following:

12 "32-10-65.1.

13 (a) Every toll established under this article must expire after a specified period of time and  
14 may be extended beyond said time by approval of the State Road and Tollway Authority.

15 (b) The proceeds of any toll established for SR 400 that is extended beyond the time  
16 necessary to pay off any debt associated with the construction of such route shall be used  
17 only for maintenance of or improvements to SR 400 or any public road connected with SR  
18 400 for which a toll is charged."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
