A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2	relating to issuance, expiration, and renewal of motor vehicle drivers' licenses, so as to
3	change certain provisions relating to issuance of licenses, contents, signature requirements,
4	and fingerprints; to change certain provisions relating to expiration and renewal of drivers'
5	licenses and reexamination requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
б	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9	issuance, expiration, and renewal of motor vehicle drivers' licenses, is amended by striking
10	Code Section 40-5-28, relating to issuance of licenses, contents, signature requirements, and
11	fingerprints, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
12	<i>"</i> 40-5-28.
13	The department shall, upon payment of the required fee, issue to every applicant qualifying
14	therefor a driver's license indicating the type or general class of vehicles the licensee may
15	drive, which license shall be upon a form prescribed by the department and which shall
16	bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, a color photograph of the
17	licensee, the licensee's full name, either a facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a
18	space upon which the licensee shall write his or her usual signature with a pen and ink
19	immediately upon receipt of the license, and such other information or identification as is
20	required by the department. In addition, any driver's license issued on or after July 1.

2003, shall indicate whether the licensee is a citizen of the United States. No license shall 21 be valid until it has been so signed by the licensee. Specifically, but without limitation, the 22

23 department may require applicants to submit fingerprints by means of an inkless fingerprint

24 scanning device upon application."

2	Said article is further amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section
3	40-5-32, relating to expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses and reexamination
4	requirements, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
5	''(a)(1) Every driver's license shall expire on the licensee's birthday in the fourth year
6	following the issuance of such license, provided that any driver's license issued to an
7	alien shall expire on the date on which such alien's legal authorization from the United
8	States Immigration and Naturalization Service to remain in the United States expires or
9	on the alien's birthday in the fourth year following the issuance of such license,
10	whichever occurs first. Every such license shall be renewed on or before its expiration
11	upon application, payment of the required fee, and, if applicable, satisfactory completion
12	of the examination required or authorized by subsection (c) of this Code section."
13	SECTION 3.

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
