A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Industries for the Blind, so as to provide that any state officer or employee may
- 3 purchase products manufactured by the industries; to provide an exception; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 2 of Title 30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 9 Industries for the Blind, is amended by adding at its end a new Code Section 30-2-10 to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 "30-2-10.
- 12 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this Code section, any state officer
- or state employee shall be eligible to purchase in any quantity products manufactured by
- the Georgia Industries for the Blind. Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 10 of Title
- 45 or any other provision of law, such a purchase by a state officer or state employee shall
- not constitute a prohibited conflict of interest and shall not be required to be reported in any
- manner.
- 18 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply to the
- 19 Commissioner of Labor or any employee of the Department of Labor designated by the
- 20 Commissioner as ineligible for application of the provisions of said subsection."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 23 without such approval.
