## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Corey Lumpkin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Corey Lumpkin serves as director of human resources at the Georgia National  
3 Fairgrounds and Agricenter in his hometown of Perry; and

4 WHEREAS, he earned his master's degree in public health at the Morehouse School of  
5 Medicine and his bachelor's degree in biology from Morehouse College, and he is a 1988  
6 graduate of Perry High School who was president of his sophomore, junior, and senior classes;

8 WHEREAS, he has held positions involving rural health care, including one at the U.S.  
9 Department of Health and Human Services Center for Primary Care Research in Rockville,  
10 Maryland, and he continues to be a strong advocate for rural health care; and

11 WHEREAS, for his performance and contributions to the Perry community since assuming  
12 his responsibilities at the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter two years ago, he was  
13 named 2002 Volunteer of the Year by the Perry Area Chamber of Commerce, one of the top  
14 two awards presented annually by that chamber; and

15 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be recognized by this body.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 commend Corey Lumpkin of Perry for his many achievements and contributions to the  
18 welfare of his community and this state.
