A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Color of Public Safety (COPS); and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Color of Public Safety (COPS) is an organization having the mission of
3 instilling in the hearts and minds of the community that everyone should be conscious of the
4 criminal justice system and that justice and fairness must be color-blind; and

5 WHEREAS, this organization is hosting a prayer breakfast during Black History Month on

8 protect our families, freedom, safety, and lives; and

10 abilities, time, resources, and opportunities to be the best servants possible while we are here

16 just, and harmonious society and convey their best wishes on the occasion of the COPS
